## Job Description - Training Specialist

## **Position Summary:**

The purpose of the position is to provide English, Cultural Orientation, Employment Readiness, Financial Literacy, driver education, health classes, and referrals through the adult education program at Exodus.

## **Responsibilities:**

- 1. Teach Cultural Orientation (CO) workshops to newly arrived clients.
- 2. Administer English language assessments and make relevant referrals.
- 3. Teach Employment Readiness Training (ERT) and Financial Literacy Training (FLT) workshops to newly arrived clients, as well as to other clients referred by agency staff.
- 4. Teach Youth Cultural Orientation workshops to newly arrived families with children in the school systems.
- 5. Assist the lead English instructor in teaching English as a Second Language (ESL) classes both virtually and inperson to Exodus clients.
- 6. Take referrals for specialist training support for refugees and provide in-home or group trainings on various topics such as health, navigating systems, etc.
- 7. Administer programming through the intake of new students, scheduling classes, reserving interpreters, arranging transportation, communicating with appropriate staff, and recording attendance.
- 8. Provide follow-up and assistance to clients who are absent from classes.
- 9. Administer assessments upon clients' completion of Cultural Orientation, securing interpretation and other assistance as needed, as well as grade and file the assessments.
- 10. Develop curricula as well as educational resources for Exodus clients.
- 11. Assist with providing referrals to other education opportunities in the community, including ESL, HSE, and higher education opportunities.
- 12. Work with the educational program staff to ensure that trainings are delivered with the highest quality and with consideration for the needs and learning styles of adult English language learners.
- 13. Detail client interactions in accordance with program requirements. Input client information in database(s) and assist with tracking and reporting as needed.
- 14. Use personal, insured vehicle and/or public transportation (where available) to travel and transport clients and materials as needed throughout the service delivery area.
- 15. Collaborate effectively with coworkers and partner organizations. Build and maintain relationships with area service providers for the benefit of clients.
- 16. Ensures that program goals and outcomes are achieved.
- 17. Attend weekly staff meetings.
- 18. Participates in Exodus staff trainings and development activities.
- 19. Participates in the on-call ER/Airport rotation.
- 20. Performs other duties as may be required by supervisor.
- 21. Reports to Manage of Self-Sufficiency Programs.

## **Position Criteria:**

- Must have a bachelor's degree with training and certification in ENL education.
- Preferably have a minimum of two years of experience in teaching ENL.
- Must possess strong interpersonal and record-keeping skills.
- Must be PC proficient, with competency in Microsoft Office applications.
- Must be a self-starter with a high level of organizational skill, flexibility, and commitment to working with immigrants of humanitarian concern.
- Must be able to function as part of a team.
- Must have a safe vehicle, valid license, and 100,000/300,000/100,000 auto insurance to transport clients.
